# Role and Purpose of the Steering Committee

- Develop GWA Board calendars and agendas
- Follow up on Board directed actions
- Support staff during implementation of the GSP
- Review and identify issues that should be brought to the full board for action along with a recommendation
  - Or to be referred to a committee for "deeper dive"
- Prepare a draft budget
- Review and apply JPA, Bylaws and Policy



# **Decision Process and Board Member Authority**

When does a member need to go back to the represented GSA?

- Not specified in JPA or Bylaws
- Can be set by Policy/Resolution of the GWA
- JPA Statutes- Exercise of Powers Act, Cal.
   Government Code §§ 6500 et seq.



## **Budget Elements and Assumption Looking Back.....**

- Grants covered professional services for GSP development
- Cost were characterized as:
  - Basic services: Monitoring, Reporting, Data Management (Zone 2 funds- local match, GWA subsidy)
  - Equal Share Split were for Public Outreach,
     Administration and Project Management
  - Annualized costs to build a reserve and cover the five year GSP cycle

### **Budget Elements and Assumption Looking Forward...**

- Need local revenues, control and funding to implement the GSP
- P68 Grant will be for \$350K. Original ask was \$500K
- Less outside professional services, County staff takes on more of the work load
- GWA Board adopted a six month budget in January of \$382K with a cost allocation approach
- Prepare a five year 'look ahead' budget



#### **Cost Allocation Approach**

- Board Cost Allocation input (January)
  - Reflect 60% groundwater pumping and 40% population cost allocation.
  - Define timing to go towards groundwater pumping only.
    When?
  - Use current and not projected pumping
  - Recognize a di minimus volume of pumping to keep costs down for small systems
- Include costs to build the reserve over 5 years
