#### **Minutes**

Wednesday, April 8, 2020 3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. Teleconference Meeting Only Call-In Information Provided Below

Meeting called to order at 3:10 pm

Roll Call taken: Roll call taken of members only. Additional folks introduced themselves.

#### **Discussion Items**

- 1. Budget and Cost Allocation. Matt presented slides. Discussed were:
  - a. 6 month budget, invoices to GSA, contract with W&C and approximate carry-over anticipated.
  - b. 68 grant funds and amount available and when available.
  - c. Zone 2 to provide funds as previously identified.
  - d. Proposed budget summary expenses and revenue. Advised will need additional from GSA's to cover all expenses. Zone 2 funds credited evenly to GSA's within Zone 2.
  - e. The proposed 60/40 split was recommended for further discussion but was not established as policy. A lot of discussions still need to be had regarding the percentage of split.
  - f. Need to take into account credits for recharge being done.
  - g. Some felt a 50/50 was a better way.
  - h. The group wanted to see different
  - i. The different budget categories may be split differently based
  - j. The biggest groundwater users are being charged less than the cities.
  - k. Should rely on actual groundwater use today and not projected rather than the actuals.
  - l. Not supportive of city paying more on groundwater than highest AG pumpers in area.
  - m. SJC 1 and SJC 2 being paid out of zone 2 which is county money. These areas should have to come up with money like the other GSA areas. Every district has to come up with funds to pay but SJC 1 and 2 do not have to be burdened with finding funds
  - n. Suggested that all GSA's be held to a minimum cost and then apply the % split to the difference (\$5000)
  - o. There was some supportive of the equal split items and would like to have further discussion on the percentage split

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- p. Might apply a membership fee of set dollar figure for applying to meetings and outreach and then percentage split on the remaining items
- q. It was observed that there are 3 components to be Budget.
  - 1) base or admin fee,
  - 2) costs split upon 16 GSA members.... could be called fixed costs
  - 3) variable cost split and would be included in each section
- r. Chairman can appoint ad-hoc committee members. Parties noted that it's a tight time frame to get the budget done. If a decision is going to be made in June, everyone needs an opportunity to weigh in before a final decision is made.
- s. GSAs need to schedule meeting to review the proposed draft budget.
- t. Decision Process
  - 1) Ad Hoc review costs allocation and budget alternatives and make a recommendation to the Steering Committee
  - 2) Steering Committee Makes a recommendation to the GWA Board
  - 3) GWA refers the draft budget to the GSA's for input
  - 4) GWA Board adopts budget with due consideration of the GSA input
- u. Decision Schedule
  - 1) 4/22 Ad Hoc TAC.
  - 2) 4/29 Special SC meeting
  - 3) 5/13 Regular SC and GWA Board meeting
  - 4) 5/14-5/29 Window for GSA review
  - 5) 6/10 Regular SC and GWA Board meeting

#### **Budget Action Items**

- 1. Apply a base amount of \$5000 from all and then do 50/50 or 60/40 on remaining cost items. Prepare new comparison charts.
- Convene and schedule an Ad Hoc Budget Committee to discuss budget and then bring back to May SC meeting. Volunteers include Brandon Nakagawa (SSJID), Mel Lytle (City of Stockton), Andrew Watkins (SEWD), and John Herrick or Dante Nomallini (ag district with low groundwater use)
- 2. Prop 68 Grant Agreement Update. The acceptance letter from DWR was received. Negotiation on agreement with final 5/15. DWR want to amended the existing agreement to get funds out quickly.
- 3. Project Planning & Phase 4 Federal Relief for Infrastructure Projects. Discussed a planned federal relief projects to help create jobs once pandemic is resolved. Big take away is to get the projects ready designed and defined, environmental clearance. Have planning done so projects can begin. The GSA

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partners need to be ready with projects for when that door opens so we can get some projects through the door.

- 4. Regional Conservation Partnership Program. Information on the federal grant was presented. 100 % local match. Focus on partnerships and the GWA would be a great example of a partnership that would draw attention to possibly receiving these funds.
