# 6-Month Budget & Scope Constraints an JOAQUIN GROUNDWATER AUTHORITY

#### Budget through June 30, 2020

- Monitoring for spring \$87,500
- DMS \$35k
- April 1, 2020 Reporting \$75k
- Model run through 2019 \$15k
- Plan Administration \$45k-\$135k depending on approach, insurance requirements, etc.
- Outreach \$20k-\$35k

Subtotal \$278k - \$383k

# Cost Allocation for 6-Month Budget & Scope



- Recommendation is to stay with the original recommendation of a 50/50 split for modeling (groundwater pumping/population), even split items, and eastside adjust, with the following stipulations:
  - The recommendation lays out a timeframe for moving to 60/40 split (pumping/population), with the goal of incrementally moving toward a cost allocation based on groundwater pumping only.
  - Future cost allocations will use current, not projected, groundwater use numbers to provide an incentive to switch to inlieu sources.
